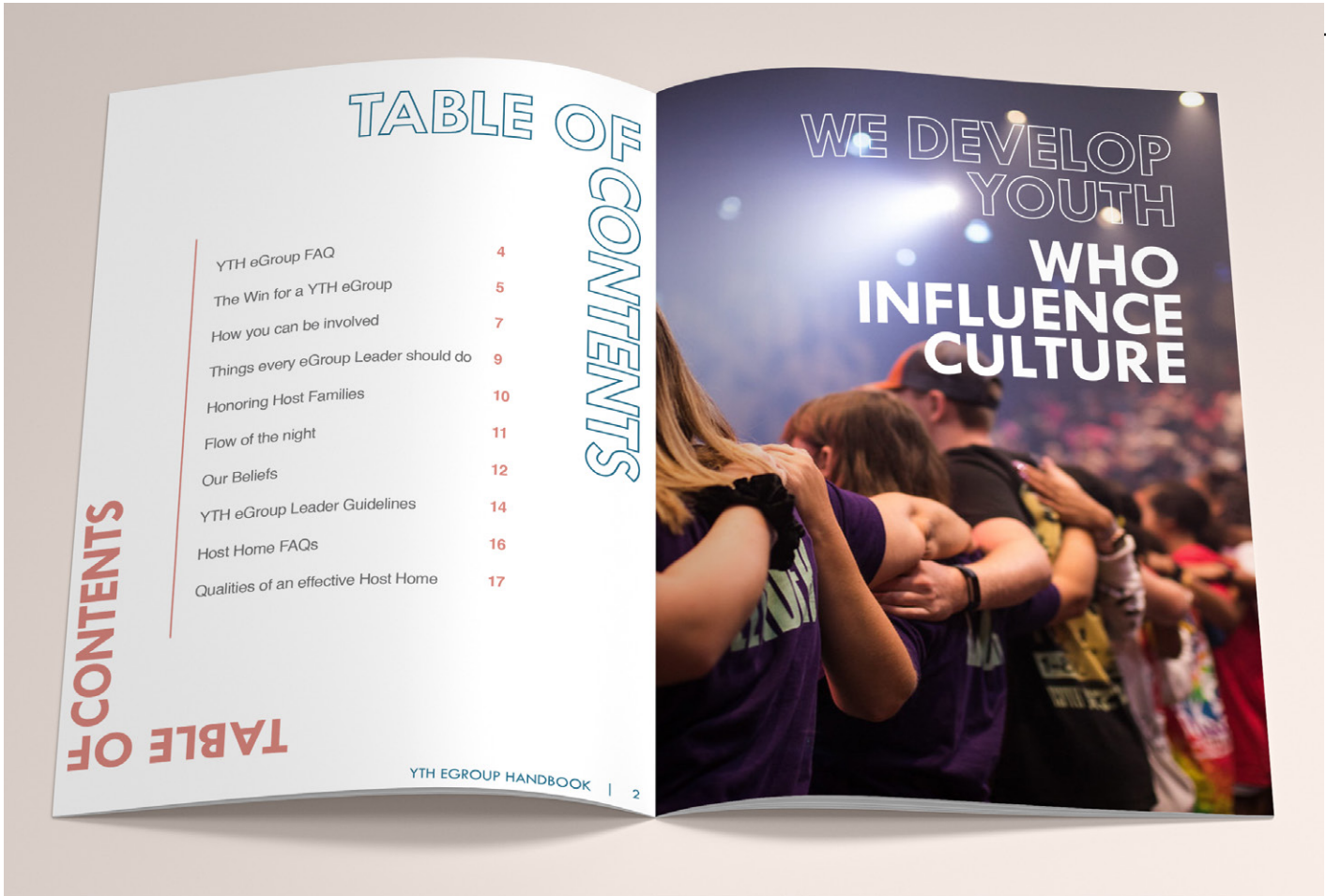
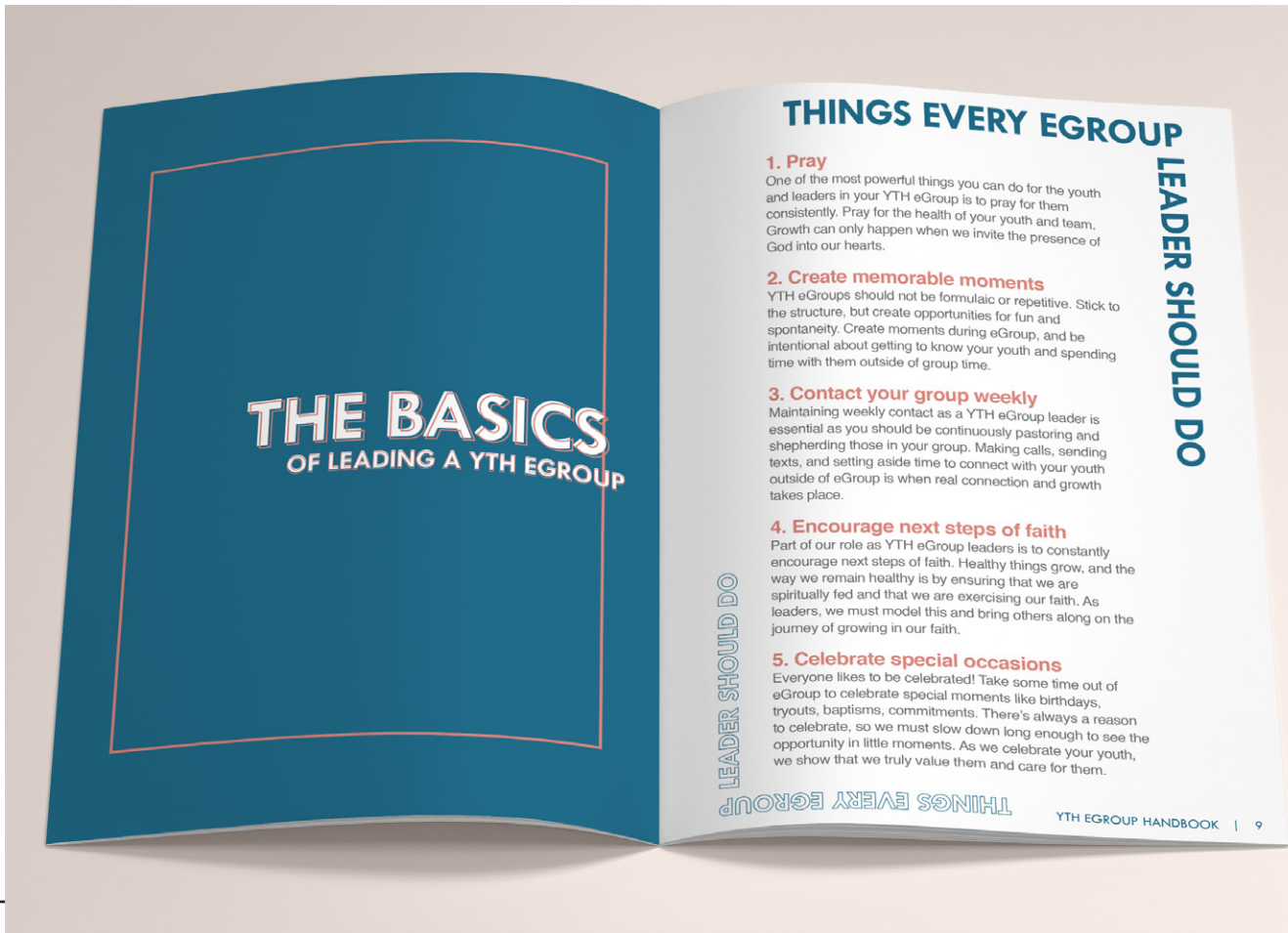

THE BASICS OF LEADING A YTH EGROUP

THINGS EVERY EGROUP LEADER SHOULD DO

- 1. Pray**
One of the most powerful things you can do for the youth and leaders in your YTH eGroup is to pray for them consistently. Pray for the health of your youth and team. Growth can only happen when we invite the presence of God into our hearts.
- 2. Create memorable moments**
YTH eGroups should not be formulaic or repetitive. Stick to the structure, but create opportunities for fun and spontaneity. Create moments during eGroup, and be intentional about getting to know your youth and spending time with them outside of group time.
- 3. Contact your group weekly**
Maintaining weekly contact as a YTH eGroup leader is essential as you should be continuously pastoring and shepherding those in your group. Making calls, sending texts, and setting aside time to connect with your youth outside of eGroup is when real connection and growth takes place.
- 4. Encourage next steps of faith**
Part of our role as YTH eGroup leaders is to constantly encourage next steps of faith. Healthy things grow, and the way we remain healthy is by ensuring that we are spiritually fed and that we are exercising our faith. As leaders, we must model this and bring others along on the journey of growing in our faith.
- 5. Celebrate special occasions**
Everyone likes to be celebrated! Take some time out of eGroup to celebrate special moments like birthdays, tryouts, baptisms, commitments. There's always a reason to celebrate, so we must slow down long enough to see the opportunity in little moments. As we celebrate your youth, we show that we truly value them and care for them.

Here are some key qualities we are looking for in a Host Home for YTH eGroups

Safe & Inviting

One of the biggest things a parent is thinking about when dropping off their youth "Is this a safe place for my child?" A Host Home should be warm and inviting place for youth. Parents should always feel at ease dropping off their youth.

Fun

Hangout time is critical for youth to connect and build friendships with each other. A great host home should have a good space for group activities for the YTH eGroup Team to setup, (Outdoor games, video games, sports, etc)

Spacious

It is important that a host home can accommodate up to 25 youth. Is there a good outdoor space? Can your home accommodate all the youth in the event of bad weather? Is there enough space to host 1 large group and space to divide the group into 2 separate groups?

Consistent

Consistency is critical for a YTH eGroup, groups meet every week and the location needs to be available consistently over the course of an academic semester (Roughly 16 weeks). We understand there will be times and circumstances where your home will not be available or you might go on vacation. These dates can be planned out and communicated in advance.
